CHAPTER 1

BACKGROUND

Man fell and was separated or disconnected from God because of sin.

- “Now The serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field which the Lord God has made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and gave to her husband with her; and he did eat. And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves aprons. And they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God amongst the trees of the garden. And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou? And he said I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself. And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. And the Lord God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat. And the Lord God said unto the serpent, Because thou has done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field: upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all

the days of thy life. And I will put enmity between thee and between the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his head. Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. And unto Adam he said because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life; Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herbs of the field; In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken for dust thou art and unto dust shalt thou return” Genesis 3:1-19.

- The above represents the source of man’s predicament. It needed fixing.
- God gave man set of rules called covenant or laws to live and run their lives.
- Man could not keep that covenant, according to God. “Behold the days come, saith the Lord, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Isreal and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they break, although I was an husband unto them, saith the Lord” Jeremiah 31: 31-32.
- This statement of fact was reiterated by the writer of the epistles to the Hebrews when expounding on the reasons for the new covenant. “For finding fault with them he saith, Behold the days come, saith the Lord when I will make a new covenant with the house of Isreal and the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord”. Hebrews 8: 8-9
- Man could only live by faith according to God. “The just shall live by his faith” Habakkuk 2:4.

- God promised his children a new covenant which is as follows, “But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the lord, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more” Jeremiah 33: 33-34.
- God explained the reason for the new covenant; man cannot obey God’s laws by their will power. Man has no will power or ability to obey. The Israelites could not.
- Man can only be willing when God’s power or Spirit is present upon and in man. “Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power” Psalm 110:3a.
- Jesus said no man came to God or to him by themselves. It was God who brought man to know God by his Spirit. “No man can come to me except the father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day” John 6:44.
- Jesus could not do anything by himself. Man cannot do anything without God working in man to love and obey God. “Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.” “I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgement is just; because I seek not my own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me” John 5:19, 30.
- Accurate understanding of the reasons why Jesus Christ came, why and what he died for is of utmost importance in the last days because no one can benefit from what they don’t know or understand.

CHAPTER 2

WHY DID JESUS COME? JOHN 12 v24

- The good news is God loved the world and His most important creation, man, and He gave his only begotten Son [the only one qualified to pay the penalty or sacrifice for the sin of man] to make it possible for God to dwell in man [the main purpose for which God created human beings] so that man can obey God willingly, walk in holiness and purity, have dominion over sin, and be assured of making it to heaven. “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his son to condemn the world; but that through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God” John 3:16-18.
- The good news is that God said He would give man help to obey Him. God would remove the stone that is hindering obedience by Himself
- No man can do what God said He would do. “A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgements and do them” Ezekiel 36:26-27.
- What God said he would do is specific. He promised to fix a problem. He gave this promise because no one else could fix it. It is easy to know in one’s own life if the problem has been fixed. You can tell if you are obeying God in full. If you are not, there is hope for you. It is possible to obey God. What you should do is to find out by seeking how this has been made possible by Jesus.
- The good news is that the ability to be saved, be delivered and walk in obedience to God is only possible through Jesus Christ by the Holy Spirit.

- Obedience and holiness is the same. Without God obedience is not possible. When the Holy Spirit indwells the believer, he does holy things.
- Man was designed by God to be inhabited by God so that God can live out their lives for them. We were created to be in perpetual union with God. Sin separated man from God. Jesus paid the price to correct and restore man to his rightful state of existence and life. Any other live apart from total union with God is dysfunctional and the reason for every problem on earth, from diseases to poverty and corruption of any kind.
- Believers who believe Jesus Christ whom God sent to die as the sacrificial Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world [John 1:36] receive the Holy Spirit who is also called the Holy Ghost, the Spirit of Christ, the Spirit of truth and the helper. The main work of the Holy Spirit is to bring man into union with God. That process is called sanctification.
- Sanctification which is the main purpose for which the Holy Spirit was given is however in three parts. First the spirit of man, then the soul and then the body. Without this threefold sanctification God cannot be fully united with man “And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray that your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ” 1 Thessalonians 5:23.
- Being born again is the beginning. Without total sanctification is like being born on this planet and remaining a one month old baby.
- This process is also referred to as transformation. We must present our bodies willing as a prerequisite for this process “I BESEECH you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God” Romans 12:1-2. This is the part we all must play.

- The good news is that what God demands from man He has fulfilled it. The problem is we are still not seeking or inquiring about what God provided. We usually think it is prophetic, elusive, or maybe it would happen at the second coming of Christ. It has been paid for in full. It is for now.
- Those who help the Holy Spirit hinder God. Those who welcome the Holy Spirit and give Him room to do what Jesus died for the Holy Spirit to come and live in man to do would enter the realm God created man for. It is called the fullness of God.
- The good news is that Jesus paid the price required with His blood so that God can dwell in man in full. This is the solution God provided for any negative situation on earth. Being born again is not the solution but a requirement or prerequisite for the fullness of God in man.
- Self righteousness is our attempt to be righteous or obey God by ourselves. It is another way of saying it was not necessary for Jesus to die. This is an unconscious situation one may find one's self.
- The Holy Spirit came because Jesus died at the cross where He surrendered His will so that God can have many sons and daughters who would willingly surrender their will to God for God's purpose for which man was created. "Verily, verily I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat falls into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit" John 12:24. Believers are the fruit of the death of Jesus Christ on the cross at Calvary.
- The life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ derived its unreplicable value from the fact that His life was offered without spot or blemish, and was offered willingly.
- God has declared that we were created for His pleasure. Just as parents enjoy their children whom they did not create, God desires to enjoy the company of His children who behave like Him. He gave the promise that His Spirit would come and prepare man for the full dwelling of God in man for God's pleasure "Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: For thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created" Revelation 4:11.

- God said the law or the Old Covenant was given as a school master to make man know what is good and bad until faith is revealed. “But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come we are no longer under a schoolmaster” Galatians 3:22-25.
- The good news is that the Holy Spirit who is also called the helper has been given to help man obey God, which was not hitherto possible for man. “For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. But finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the lord. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their minds, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God and they shall be to me a people: And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more” Hebrews 8: 7-12.
- These promises are precise and specific. These promises are what Jesus Christ died to bring into force. Believers were never meant to be stuck at just being born again.
- The promise that no man would need to teach another to know God has been ignored. We have been trying to do what God said He would do. Hence most believers are not receiving the fullness of God because we do not comprehend what God said. Attempt to teach what God said He alone would personally teach hinders God.

- God's plan is for the five fold ministry to teach about how to recognise the Holy Spirit, what the Holy spirit would do and generally how to work with the Holy Spirit instead of hindering Him. If we could do it the Holy Spirit would not have been needed, and Jesus would not have died. Emphasis and genuine effort must be put in place to identify and teach about ministerial gifts with a focus on helping to restore their function in the body of Christ.
- It is important to know that the body of Christ would not be able to fulfil its full potential without allowing the fivefold ministry to function. "And he gave some, apostles; and some prophets; and some evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: Till we all come in the unity of faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ:" Ephesians 4:11-13.
- The above would instruct every believer on the role of ministers which is to help know how to relate with the Holy Spirit the teacher. If we attempt to become the Holy Spirit, the Holy Spirit would not approve. Jesus does not mediate in what He did not die for.
- Believers don't lead the Holy Spirit. Only those that God lead are the sons of God. For as many that are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- For the Holy Spirit to do the work he was given to do, our main work is to believe God which would lead us to seek and find what our role is in God's plan for man. This plan is the fullness of God in man. The fullness means God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit in every human being who would believe. The Holy Spirit was given to prepare every believer for the fullness of God. God does not live in physical structures like cathedrals or church buildings. God lives in human beings.
- So the good news is good because it is the solution God provide for human beings to put the fullness of God in man.
- The Fullness of God is the purpose of the gospel of the kingdom of God. This is the only solution God in His infinite mercies provided to take care of everything that has gone wrong in and with man.

- The good news is that the Holy Spirit has been made available by Jesus to help man walk in dominion, mortify the flesh and be holy. This is for those who believe; who ask with full assurance by faith that what God said He would do, He would do. And what God said He would do no human being can do it. “For if ye live after the flesh, ye would die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body ye shall live” Romans 8: 13.
- “Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith the Lord of host” Zechariah 4:10. The New Covenant is the dispensation of the Holy Spirit. This is what every believer and soon to be believers must know.
- A conscious choice has to be made by all to allow the Spirit of God the access into their lives to complete his mission.

CHAPTER 3

WHAT TO DO TO ENJOY THE FULLNESS OF GOD

- First and foremost, you need to be saved or born again. “Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God” John 3:3. We receive the new birth when we become born again. The process is as follows: “For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation” Romans 10:10. You may have to be led in saying the sinners prayer of repentance, privately or publicly as long as you make your declaration publicly according to the above scripture
- Next, you follow God’s command. “BUT SEEK FIRST THE KINGDOM OF GOD, AND HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS; AND ALL THESE THINGS SHALL BE ADDED UNTO YOU” [Matthew 6:33]. This command is without exceptions and cannot be done for you. You would have to do it yourself. You Inquire and pursue. It is the only way to success in life. God’s strategy and hope is that you follow God’s commandment.
- Jesus taught; “Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock and it shall be opened unto you: for everyone that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.” Matthew 7:7-8. This looks almost like a blank cheque given to all to fill in as they wish. This is God’s only recipe for success in life. By following this command you would discover God’s purpose for your live and the approved means of getting there.
- Pastors and Bible teachers are available to assist you on your journey. Their primary role in your life is to teach and show you how to know and cooperate with the Holy Spirit.

BASIC TRUTHS ABOUT THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST

- The purpose of the gospel is salvation in every area of life.
- The purpose of the New Covenant is sanctification; Spirit, soul and body. It is our duty to find out what sanctification means and how to receive it. God uses sanctification to bring us into seeing everything and understanding every situation in life the same way God sees it. The way we talk, look after our families, conduct our business and life would be brought under the scrutiny of the Holy Spirit.
- Without sanctification, one is still in bondage. To fulfil ones destiny without sanctification is actually impossible. The devil would ensure that it does not happen. We can only have what God says we would have without interference from the devil when we see everything the way God sees it and make the choice to follow only God's plan.
- Sanctification involves chastening and trials. It is for purification.
- Every New Covenant blessing is bestowed. No one deserves it. We can't earn it, but it is bestowed by Jesus who rewards those who diligently seek him [See Hebrews 11:6].
- The purpose or end of sanctification is the indwelling Christ or the fullness of God.
- The purpose of the fullness of God is the kingdom of God. Fullness of God in man is the kingdom of God in man
- Kingdom of God in man is the purpose for which God created human beings. Man was created in God's own image physically, whilst the Holy Spirit recreates us internally through sanctification and character transformation.
- Sanctification of the body removes every ailment or medical conditions. It is a total package.
- The above is the only solution God provided through the gospel for every situation on the planet earth. Whether it is any form of disease, poverty, marriage, bringing up children, government, creativity or anything conceived or yet to be conceived.
- The Bible shows us God's will or plans for everyone. The Holy Spirit was given to interpret the Bible.

CHAPTER 4

THE WAY FORWARD

- “Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent” John 6:29. To believe is crucial to receiving from God or becoming who God created us to be.
- One of the mission of the Holy Spirit as a helper is to help believers to believe. Without believing there can be no fulfilment of God’s plans for the individual who professes to be a believer. “But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become sons of God, even to them that believe on his name” John 1:1. Those who believe, become sons of God.
- Those who believe, enter into God’s rest. God’s rest in the scriptures generally refers to the fulfilment of God’s promises in the individual’s life. “Let us therefore fear, lest a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the gospel preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. For we which have believed do enter into rest,” Hebrews 4:1-3a
- Faith is that through which heaven hears us. Faith is the language of heaven and the only way God relates to man. Hence it would do every believer good to know all that can be known about faith.
- Faith is the prescribed action we take to attain or receive God’s promises. Faith is what we do because it is what God said we should do to achieve our desired goals. “Now Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen” Hebrews 11:1. The substance or action we take, which serves as an evidence or proof of what we hope to see come to pass in our lives, is faith.
- Those who take the prescribed action, because of who they believe, enter into rest. This rest is a quiet assurance that what God said He would do, He would do. This is what generates manifestation of promises.
- The source and access of faith is the word of God. “So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God” Romans 10:17.

- To acquire faith is to acquire the most important ingredient in your walk as a believer. Faith in God's kingdom equals success in your Christian walk and success in life. Faith comes into play from the beginning of our walk with God at new birth or regeneration when we believed into righteousness, and through every single dealing or encounter with God.
- Faith connects you to God, doubt or unbelief disconnects you from God. Unbelief is the most formidable enemy of any believer. The enemy we would fight and must prevail over through the help of the Holy Ghost all the days of our life on earth. Unbelief is the stronghold Satan came to establish in man, and his main business is to ensure it stays intact or reinforced.
- The word of God interpreted by the Holy Spirit also referred to as rhema is the source of faith and the weapon Satan fears most apart from the blood of Jesus. Revelation generates faith. We should always seek revelation about every word of God. For instance, revelation about the blood of Jesus and all that the blood of Jesus did and means to a believer is victory on its own. It is a weapon of warfare.
- The source of faith is revelation; revelation is the anointing that teaches. "But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him" 1 John 2:27.
- Look for a Bible teaching Church with a very strong emphasis on prayer.
- Every single promise of the New Covenant is for the diligent praying believer.
- Ask also for the power of the Holy Ghost to be a doer of the word.

DANGER

- The New Covenant promise does not apply to those who deliberately go and sin. "What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?" Romans 6:1-2

- “For if we sin wilfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of judgement and fiery indignation which shall devour the adversaries.” Hebrews 10:26-27.
- The above scriptures give us God’s perspective about sin. Sin disconnects us from God, robs us and gives God’s enemies room to blaspheme. God hates sin. But when we sin we have an advocate in Jesus 1 John 2:1. We may be chastened by God, but it is because he loves us, “And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him: For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth. If you endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons” Hebrews 12:5-8. When God refuse to chastened anyone, it is usually because God may have removed his mercy from that person. This happens after repeated warnings.
- God love those who are quick to repent. If you are not sure of your actions you are in enemy territory. Repent.
- When we sin, we must ask for forgiveness immediately. We should also confess to one another as the word of God commanded. “Confess your fault one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much” James 5:16.
- Prepare yourself for success. A fully sanctified believer is successful believer. You become a success story. Glory to God!
